Family Connection



Gather at the family table or in a room that is quiet and comfortable. Read aloud this Sunday's Gospel Reading (Luke 7:11-17). If your family enjoys dramatizing, assign parts and reenact the Gospel.

Note that Jesus responded to the widow's loss with a miracle; he restored the gift of life to her son. In doing this, he showed respect for the widow, compassion for her loss, and concern for her continued well-being.

Respect, compassion, concern for the well-being of others—these are virtues practiced toward one another in a Christ like family. Talk together about how and when these virtues were manifested in your family during the past week. If you have difficulty thinking of examples of any one of them, make a serious effort during the coming week to practice these virtues. Join together in praying:

Our Father, who art in heaven,
Hallowed be thy name;
Thy kingdom come,
Thy will be done
in our home as it is in heaven. Amen.
