Washington Interfaith Network: For many years, the District of Columbia has had a broad-based coalition of churches, the Washington Interfaith Network (WIN), to help bring areas of concern to the City Council. In Prince George's County, there was such a coalition as well, and I'm told that Msgr. Scanlon was an active participant. A couple years ago, an initial effort was made to re-start the program. Mr. Coleman Milling contacted Fr. Scott Hahn at St. Jerome's in Hyattsville as well as many other clergy. We had an initial meeting in July and plan to have another meeting in September. The ultimate goal is to train church members who are interested in communicating with members of the County Council about a broad number of issues that affect our churches and communities. Some of the issues include, but are not limited to criminal justice reform, housing revitalization, affordable housing, mental health programs, etc. If you are interested in learning more about this effort, please contact me at 301-459-4814.
